Name of the Institution: PES's College of Arts and Science Farmagudi Goa.

SECTION A

History

PES College was established in the year 1986 by the combined efforts of many prominent

educationists and social workers of Ponda City. The fact that, students of Ponda taluka and

surrounding areas had to travel long distances to obtain higher education on completion of their

HSSC studies, as there was no general higher education facility available in Ponda at that time.

Besides, education was beyond the reach of the poorer section of society. As a result, the poor

and deserving students in this area who could not afford to travel long distances were deprived of

higher education. Thus the Ponda Education Society's decision to start the College came as a

welcome idea which would help the majority of the students in Ponda taluka.

The Society approached the then Chief Minister of Goa, Shri. Pratap Singh Rane for the present

premises at Farmagudi which is owned by the Tourism Department, Government of Goa. This

building of the Government was not in use for many years. The Government of Goa, leased the

building along with 35,000 square meters of land to Ponda Education Society for 5 years. Thus

the College was started on 20th June 1986. In 1992, the present President Shri. Ravi S. Naik, the

then Chief Minister of Goa, converted the lease from 5 years to 99 years for the betterment of the

educational institution.

The College is housed in a well-ventilated building at Farmagudi, which is ideal for this

purpose. Adequate laboratory and library facilities are provided. The building is situated on a

high altitude in a calm and quite atmosphere, ideal for studies.

The management has selected a team of dynamic and experienced lecturers for teaching and

providing guidance to students. Many students of this area being first generation learners are

admitted without any special screening, but with the help of hard-working, dynamic and

experienced teachers, they are provided with the best education and guidance which helps them to graduate with flying colors. Since 1986, twenty three batches of students appeared for TY

Examination conducted by GOA UNIVERSITY. Thousands of them have successfully graduated and settled. Many of them are holding good position and doing well in life.

Vision

Is to be a centre of higher education that prepares youth for becoming capable, useful and upright citizens, able to face the challenges faced by the country and global village.

Mission

We aim to achieve our vision... By ensuring that our faculty is highly qualified and committed to the transference of high levels of knowledge and values to the students.

By promoting activities that inculcate student community interaction for meeting the local needs. By evolving programmes that will enable the students to find practical applications of the knowledge gained. By providing an atmosphere where an all around development of personality is possible.

The courses offered at undergraduate in the Arts Stream are: English, Hindi, Konkani, Marathi, , Economics, History, Philosophy, Information Technology, Political Science and Psychology and in the Science Stream: Botany, Chemistry, Industrial Chemistry, Information Technology, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology, and Microbiology. Some of these subjects are offered as six units and three units at T.Y. level.

The Ponda Education Society has initiated massive infrastructural development at the College. As a result of this, infrastructure will be available for curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities. Infrastructural facilities like science laboratory block, multimedia-equipped seminar halls, classrooms, computer lab, computerized library, well equipped faculty offices, play ground, gymkhana, new canteen, well maintained ladies common room, spacious well-laid four-wheeler and two-wheeler parking space and new space for administrative offices. The entire

campus and the administrative buildings are being re-engineered. Many of the science laboratories will be upgraded to carry out research by faculties.

SECTION B

In the current academic year, a total of 781 students enrolled with 222 boys and 559 girls. The performance of our students at the B.A./B.Sc. University Examination was excellent, as usual. At T.Y.B.A. there were 4 Distinctions, 31 First Classes, 33 Second Classes and 34 Pass Classes. The College Pass Percentage was 87.93%. At T.Y.B.Sc. with 63 Distinctions, 44 First Classes, 4 Second Classes and 10 Pass Classes. College Pass Percentage was 94.53%. Our students Ms. Prachi Bhatt stood First and secured Gold Medal at B.Sc. Degree Examination in Physics (6 units) of Goa University and Ms. B. Tabsum of Physics / Maths combination secured First Rank and Gold Medal for Girl Student at B.Sc. Degree Examination of Goa University. Miss Sampada Upadhye, Philosophy/Psychology Student stood Third at the University T.Y. B.A. Examination. This commendable academic performance was due to the efforts of our highly qualified and dedicated faculty members It is a matter of pride for us that we have total 42 teaching staff members out of which 27 Ph. D's and 15 M. Phils. Our Staff

Members Ms. Deeparani Prabhu and Shri. Vikas Pissurlekar were awarded Ph.D. degrees by Goa. University this year while Shri. Girish Kundaikar and Mrs Padmaja Kamat have submitted their Ph. D. thesis. This year our students performed extremely well in the field of sports and showed a great enthusiasm in the activities under the guidance of Shri D. M. Desai., Physical Director. Master Sumit Naik won the Gold Medal in Power Lifting and Best Physique and was honored the title Iron Man and Shree by Goa University. He also won Gold Medal in Judo Competition events organized by Goa University. He also bagged Gold Medal in Power Lifting & Best Physique

Events and was declared Iron Man by Damodar College of Commerce and Economics. Master Vinayak Desai won Bronze Medal in Judo competition organized by Goa University.

Master Samir Noronha won Bronze Medal in Swimming Competition organized by Goa University.

Master Aaron Pereira won Gold, Miss Basobi Shaikh won Silver and Miss Alvita Pereira won Bronze Medal in Inter-Collegiate Athletic Championship organized by Goa University. The Dept of Physical Education organised All Goa Inter-Collegiate Best Physique Competition. The winners were awarded Trophies, Medals & Cash prizes. 13 Colleges participated in the Event.

The NSS unit of our College carried various activities like Orientation for the students and in collaboration with Directorate of Health Services, Government of Goa organized Anti filarial and Diabetes Awareness Programmes in Ponda Taluka The Unit also organized Annual Camp under the guidance of Programme officer Dr. P. □ The College has a examination committee with a senior teacher as a convener with seven members for effective management of ISA & SEE. The committee carries the functions allotted, which include the collection of question papers, preparation of examination schedules, conducting of examinations, collection of assessed answer sheets and preparation of results. This ensures the smooth functioning of the examination without burdening a certain section of teachers. Secondly, all the teachers submit typed question paper; this has minimized manual error and enhanced proof reading of the question papers.

 \Box Though the University has allowed flexibility in the conduct of ISA, the college has adopted a uniform pattern for effective functioning of the same. The College conducts two ISA \Box s in two different modes. The first is written examination conducted as per a certain schedule intimated in advance to the students. Secondly, the written assignment followed by oral.

□ Notices are displayed on notice boards at various locations of the schedule of examination and marks allocations for each of the examination. Further, at the time of admission, each student is given a handbook which gives the schedule of the examination. This is essential to ensure students appear for both the ISA's as it is a prerequisite for being eligible for appearing at SEEs (Semester End Examinations)

☐ Lastly, to have zero error result, the examination committee scrutinize individual entry of each paper before the final feeding of the result.

42. Action Taken Report on the AQAR of the previous year

The process for internal quality checks has been put in place by the College through the establishment of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell from academic year 2011-12. The IQAC plays a key role in the quality assurance efforts within the existing academic and administrative system. The IQAC receives inputs from every department – both academic and administrative – about their perspective plans which spell among other things, measures that would be taken for quality assurance and up-gradation.

The departments prepare their perspective plans, course evaluation by students, Faculty Improvement Programme, research and other activities of the faculty, as well as general evaluation of the curriculum.

The inputs coming from the departments, and the review of its own past performance are used to prepare the action plan. On the basis of these departmental inputs, the College Planning board prepares the institutions perspective plan. The Annual College Calendar then spells out time bound targets which are set on the basis of its perspective plan. This College Calendar acts as one of the tools that are used for monitoring actual performance at the institutional level. Rectification measures are deployed in case there is a variance in actual performance. Reviews of the performance at the departmental levels as well as institutional level are done through periodic meetings. Departments meet regularly to review the academic as well as administrative performance and to adopt rectification measures in case the performance falls below the targets. The Principal holds monthly meetings with faculty, more frequent meetings with the heads of the departments and daily meetings with the administrative sub-heads in order to ensure smooth implementation of the College plan/calendar. These mechanisms at the Department and the College levels ensure the sustenance and enhancement of quality.

Besides the College Calendar that helps in setting the targets for the institutional efforts, there are other programmes and support facilities that provide for internal quality checks.
